Jill argues that there are a lot of kids in band because of the trip. Currently 90 on the list to go. Parent chaperones will pay half of their portion. Students are raising money toward their cost. The budget has room but more focusing on principle of the idea of setting a precedent of paying 100% for anyone. Jill says it's in part thanking them for the endless amounts of hours they've put in and recognizing that they currently have no income.
