Minutes for October 7, 2014

Call to Order: The regular monthly meeting was called to order by President Sheri Byrne at 7:05 pm in the DHS Town Center.

Secretary's Report: The meeting minutes from September were presented and are also on the website for review. There were no questions. Theresa Schindler motioned to approve the minutes and the motion passed.

End of Season Marching Band Celebration: Brian Jensen reported that the date has been set for October 28th at 7:00 pm. He asked for the Music Boosters to reimburse the caterers for ice cream in the amount of \$350.00. The motion passed.

Marching Band Invitational: We heard good reports about the competition! We had lots of support from the Booster parents. We learned that we printed too many programs (450) as we only sold 140. We ran out of food in the concessions so that was a good thing since we didn't want to have too much leftover. Everything went smoothly for the first year.

Fundraising: Cheesecake Sales: 501 cheesecakes were sold and will be delivered on 10/16/14. Profit per cheesecake is \$6.00

Marching Band DVD Fundraiser: Brian Jensen will chair this.

IMEA Jazz Festival: It is to be held on November 1. We still need chairs for:

Old/New Business:

Jen Reece asked the Music Boosters for \$100.00 to help pay for the honorary Jazz Festival judge. She was approached by two other schools who said they would both contribute \$100.00. This is supposed to be an awesome judge that just normally judges All-State, so we're lucky to have him. Charles Webber motioned to approve this expenditure and the motion passed.

There are still some opening chair positions on the list of committees.

Directors' Reports:

Jen Reece (Choir): The Chorus Concert is October 16th at 1:45 and 7:00 pm. We will be introducing a new director for DVMS.....Mrs. Seamore. Jen wants to ask the boosters to pay for lunch for kids going to IMEA at Augustana College. There will be around 40-45 kids but she will get us the exact number. \$6.00 each for Junior IMEA and \$8.00 each for Senior IMEA. October 17 the Madrigals and parents are working at the football game in order to make up for the loss in the Madrigal budget this year. We will be working concessions, 50/50, and the VIP parking lot. All the junior high bands will be participating in this game, so we are hoping for even more support. It should be a good money making night!

Jill Potts (Band): Cheerleaders are selling car decals for all sports but are just too overwhelmed to sell for music, so Jill is going to sell them. It will have a music note on it for band or chorus. They will be \$10.00 each. Michelle Unser will put it on the website so we can order them if we would like. Next week is a busy week for the Cadet Band as they have a performance at a Monday night game, the Friday night football game, and both bands go to a competition at Southern Illinois University on October 18th.

Robin Hunt (Theatre): The fall play opens Thursday, October 9th and Friday, October 10th. She will take one week off then will start workshops with Jill Potts for the musical "South Pacific". Robin is getting applications for DHS to join the International Thespian Society Fraternity. Kids that are involved with all aspects of theatre can join. They need a certain number of points to join. DHS needed six kids to join in order to begin a chapter but 27 kids have joined!

Sheri heard talk that there was some “calendar confusion”. We are the DUNLAP MUSIC BOOSTERS and that’s how it will appear on the calendar. The Dunlap Boosters is the Athletic Boosters.
