## Director and Committee Reports

Mid-Illini honor band will be held on March $13^{\text {th }}$ at Washington High School. There are 10 band students participating.

Orchestra: Felix Yang won the Peoria Symphony Youth Artist Competition. He will perform with the symphony at an upcoming event.

Theater: Rehearsals for Group Interp and Contest Play continue. The opening show will be held on February $13^{\text {th }}$ at 7:00 pm. Sections will be held on March $16^{\text {th }}$ at Olympia High School. State will be held at Peoria Civic Center on March 22-23.

Chorus: Master and Women's Choral participated in solo and ensemble competition. The middle schools will attend competition next week. The Jazz Choir mics arrived and are being utilized. Fine Arts Night will be held at DHS on April $12^{\text {th }}$.
