Representatives from the Travel Company, chaperones, and staff will be available to walk us through trip itinerary and procedures, help with a variety of paperwork that has to be filled out for each traveler, and answer any questions/concerns you may have as we approach the Savannah Tour. Completed paperwork will also be turned in that evening.

- Payment of \$200 was due Nov. 20th. Invoices have been home and we are still accepting checks. Future payment dates are Feb 20th \$200, § April 15th will be the remaining balance. All payments are payable to DHS Music Boosters.
- 90 singers, 12 chaperones, and 2 directors are committed to go to Georgia. Cost is \$1060 per student. Students are choosing bus seat partners this week!!! 141 days to go!!!!
- An updated itinerary has been posted on <u>www.eaglemusic.net</u>. Plans have begun to secure performance venues and activities.
- 12 chaperones have been secured; 8 students per adult. Cost for a chaperone after Music Boosters pays half is around \$625 for double room rate instead of the student quad rate.
