Activities:

Youth In Harmony: "T.B.A." will travel to Bloomington October 27th to participate in the Youth In Harmony Barbershop Festival. The boys will get to work with professionals in the field and practice/perform with 200+ other singers "barbershop" style. The Concert is at the Bloomington Center for the Performing Arts at 6:30PM. Tickets are \$5.

- Payment of \$200 is due Nov. 20th. Invoices will be sent home in early November. Those fundraising may wait to subtract their profits before turning in their check or may apply it to the next payment in February. Future payment dates are Feb 20th \$200, \$ April 20th remaining balance. All payments are payable to DHS Music Boosters.
- 90 singers, 12 chaperones, and 2 directors are committed to go to Georgia. Cost is \$1060 per student.
- An updated itinerary has been posted on <u>www.eaglemusic.net</u>. Plans have begun to secure performance venues and activities.
- 12 chaperones have been secured; 8 students per adult. Cost for a chaperone after Music Boosters pays half is around \$625 for double room rate instead of the quad rate.

Concert donations – \$2 donations will be collected before every concert at DHS. Profits from concerts range between \$400 - \$800 and help support the Music Boosters efforts to raise chaperone money for Savannah and other projects supported by the Boosters.
